100% of rental fee and Security Deposit is required at the time of booking. **Make check payable to Shree Radhey Shyam Temple.** This agreement will remain in force until revoked in writing by either party at least 2 weeks before the event for full refund. After this grace period only 50% will be refunded. Security Deposit will be refunded to applicant within two weeks.

Rules and Regulations

1. Only **Vegetarian** food and **Non-alcoholic beverages** to be served on the premises including parking area.
2. Use of duct tapes, staples and nails that could damage the walls are not allowed to décor the rented area. All decorations must be removed at the end of the event.
3. All food complementing Prasad must be served in the basement only. Under no circumstance's food is allowed in the prayer hall. **Don't leave any leftover food** in the Temple. You may leave Paper plates, Napkins etc. for Temple use.
4. Lessee must **clean** the temple premises including **kitchen, Basement and other areas** after their function. Vacuum cleaner is available in the building. The accumulated trash must be tied in plastic bags and must be placed in the garbage containers outside the Temple building. Garbage bags must not be placed on the floor as the rodents and other animals will tear off the bags and litter the garbage.
5. The chairs and tables are to be kept in prearranged and in pre-rental format. The items that belong to the Temple should not be taken away from temple premises. After the event, make sure the **lights, fans, Ovens, Gas Ranges, water taps and kitchen appliances are turned off.**
6. **Please Maintain Silence in the Prayer Hall**

Shree Radhey Shyam Temple is not responsible for any injury occurring while on temple premises to lessee or their invited guests. Parents are responsible for their children's safety.
